SUMMARY: The United States Agency for International Development (USAID) gives notice that it has prepared a Privacy Impact Assessment (PIA) summary for its Alliance Network (ALLNet), operated by the Bureau for Management. The USAID Alliance Network (ALLNET) is a robust data network designed to facilitate the communication and interaction with individuals and groups outside of the USAID network around the world. ALLNET provides a forum for the creation of applications to facilitate communication and knowledge sharing between USAID, its partner organizations, and Foreign Service Nationals (FSNs). ALLNET is a platform for the hosting of applications that can be securely shared between USAID personnel and other groups they designate. It will allow USAID to improve the efficiency of project implementation by providing tools and resources directly to the partner organizations implementing the projects. ALLNET processes sensitive but unclassified (SBU) information, specifically information and technology management and humanitarian aid information in support of USAID's mission.
