## PRIVACY IMPACT ASSESSMENT SUMMARY

**System Name:** TraiNet

**Managing Office:** USAID Bureau for Economic Growth, Agriculture and Trade, Office of Education

**SUMMARY:** The United States Agency for International Development (USAID) gives notice that it has conducted a Privacy Impact Assessment (PIA) for TraiNet. TraiNet is a Java-based web application with a Postgres backend database which holds data regarding foreign nationals who receive instruction funded by USAID. Additional information is gathered for participants whose training will take place in the US. TraiNet serves as a repository of all USAID-funded training and education activities implemented in country, or in the U.S.

**What elements of PII are being collected?**

**For foreign nationals:** TraiNet collects full Name, gender, date of birth, email address, phone, address, country of birth, country of residence, country of citizenship, photograph, passport number.

**Why is the PII being collected?**

**For foreign nationals:** TraiNet collects this information to gather program-related data pertaining to all USAID-funded in-country, third-country and U.S. training and exchange visitor events, and to track their attendance at training programs and to obtain a visa for travel to the US.

**What opportunities are provided to individuals to consent to the use of this information collection?**

Participation is voluntary unless required by contractual mechanisms between USAID and the USAID partner organization.

**What is the Agency's intended use of the information?**

**For foreign nationals:** To gather program-related data pertaining to all USAID-funded in-country, third-country and U.S. training and exchange visitor events, and to track their attendance at training programs and to obtain a visa for travel to the US.

**Who has access to the information?**

Only system users who have access to this information and only on a need-to-know basis.

**Information Security**

The system is protected by secure internet communication protocol (HTTPS) and required login and password. In addition, the systems are protected by security scans and all manner of physical security.

**Does this collection require a System of Record Notice?**

No. (Foreign National data).
