# Sustainable Development

## Goal 4:

Ensure inclusive and quality education for all and promote lifelong learning.

# SDG 4 Target:

By 2030, ensure that all girls and boys complete free, equitable and **quality** primary and secondary education leading to relevant and **effective learning outcomes**.

# What Does this Mean?:

- New global focus on learning outcomes
- Increased government, donor and partner interest in assessment data
- Imperative for higher quality data
- Imperative to define and standardize procedures for data collection and analysis

# EGRA as an Open Source Tool:

- Advantages: Widely available, highly adaptable, and anyone can use it;
- Disadvantages: High variability in the reliability and validity of data collected.

To improve the quality of the data collected using EGRA tools by providing guidance to governments, USAID partners, and other stakeholders that administer EGRA to monitor learning outcomes.
